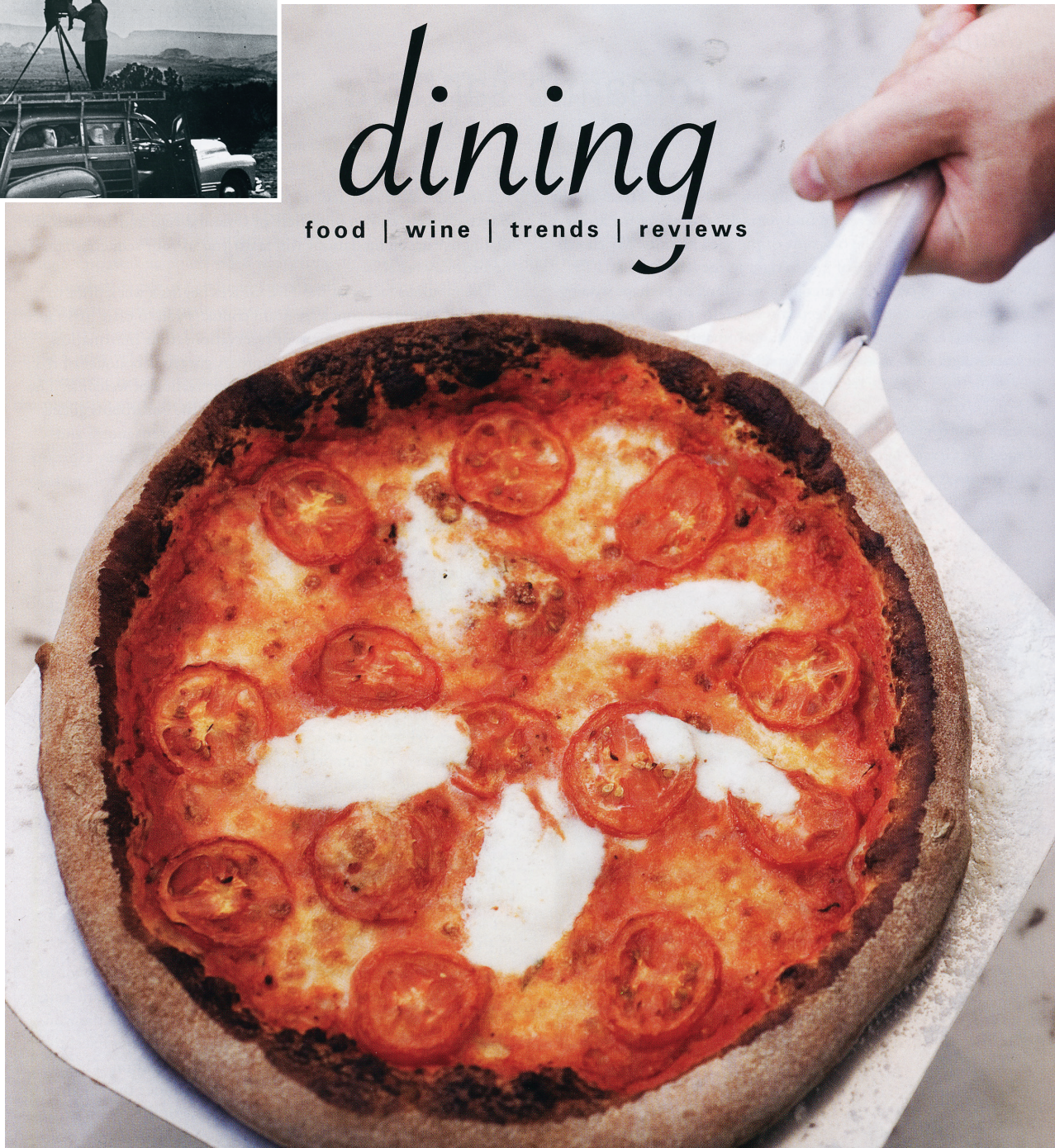

Pie-eyed

Santa Fe sure is a pizza-loving town. You'd think you were in Naples with all the pizza joints around. The new pie on the block is Pizza Centro, tucked into the Santa Fe Design Center, with a second location in the Agora Center in suburban Eldorado. Brothers Nathan and Jason Aufrichtig—he also owns Counter Culture—have done their homework, studying with a variety of pie-meisters on their native East Coast to create the perfect New York-style version, complete with classic thin crust and clever toppings. The pie names are a tribute to the Big Apple, too: Alphabet City is a handful of veggie ingredients, including flash-fried eggplant, and Chelsea appeals to meat lovers (like myself) and is teeming with sausage, meatballs, and bacon.
